SAVED BY HIS LIFE

Jesus appeared to John on Patmos. He declared that He was dead, but now He lives forevermore (Revelation 1:18). Jesus saves because of what He does now, qualified by what He did back then (Hebrews 2:10). Paul affirmed, "For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life" (Romans 5:10 NKJV). The suffering and death of Christ qualified Him to function as our High Priest before God at this hour.

Our Lord's present ministry must be kept in mind as one ponders, "I have a Savior." He is our Mediator (1 Timothy 2:5). He is our Advocate, face-to-face with the Father (1 John 2:1). 
