Midnight Sun Bible Camp is open for business and ready for all campers to come and enjoy this God centered facility!

We'll almost ready. It's nothing that a couple hundred man-hours shouldn't be able to do.

It just needs a few things done to get it ready for use before the camp sessions start on June 30 with the 1st of two family camps.

Minor things like: get the water flowing, service the generators, rake the leaves, clean the cabins, rake more leaves, mow the lawns, weed whack and be whacked backed, clean all the other buildings, fix the boats, groom the road, check supplies, test the fishing poles, drag out all the recreational equipment that we just put away only 9 months ago...

There might be some minor touch up painting or building repairs. We would like to complete some unfinished projects then start some new soon-to-be unfinished projects.

There are also some pre-camp projects that will require lots of help:

- Install chain link fence and gate around dumpster area to keep the bears out
- Install underground wiring to bathhouses and beyond
- Make additional subterranean storage room in the camp's most favorite and highly used outhouse
- Cleanup around generator area

For those of you that want to do bigger projects, two are on the schedule this year. This is a two week long effort for these projects starting on June 10 through June 25.

- Finish the stairs to the new deck on the Hilton
- Move generators and fuel storage to new lined pad and berm

These projects do require some skills but not absolutely required. Helping hands are what is needed. Meals will be provided and hot showers too as long as the prep crew gets them going easier than last year's start up went.

If you have a camp key, turn it in today. Sometime after July 1 it won't work anymore. We are missing quite a few keys and are accountable for each one to the Park Service. Please don't make camp pay \$50 per key to replace them. Turn them in.

Weekend work dates are:

- June 10, 17 and 24.
- June 30 is the start of Family Camp, however any must-do projects/repairs not finished will be done on July 1.

As of this writing, the camp road is passable but rutted. 4WD is always recommended but is passable in 2WD with high clearance. If you don't know what that means, don't drive on the road just yet.

Remember, you need a key to get in and out. Return your unused key today so others may use them!
