THE BIBLE HAS MUCH TO TEACH THOSE

... One Baptism ...
(Part I)

In Ephesians 4:5 the Bible teaches us that for the church there is ONE BAPTISM. Lets learn what Baptism is and what it does. In Acts 8:36-38 we see that Baptism is immersion in water. The word Baptism in the original Greek means “immerse”. The Bible teaches a great deal about it.

- Jesus clearly taught that it was necessary – Mark 16:16
- Jesus taught His followers to perform it and teach everyone. – Matthew 28:19-20
- Jesus exempld it – Matthew 3:13-17, Mark 1:9-11
- The Apostles taught it at their first opportunity – Acts 2:19-42
- They taught that it would apply to everyone – Matthew 28:19, Acts 2:38-39
- They taught that its necessity would continue for all time – Acts 2:39
- It was applied in all conversions even when Apostles were surprised – Acts 10:47-48
- The History of Early church growth (Acts) gives many examples - Acts 2:24; 8:12, 13, 38; 9:18; 10:48; 16:15, 33; 18:8; 19:5
- Sometimes Baptism was commanded by the teacher – Acts 22:16
- Sometimes Baptism was requested by the student – Acts 8:36
- It was such a natural part of the teaching that sometimes it wasn’t even mentioned in the written Word; but it was obeyed - Acts 8:12-13,8:35-38; 16:15, 16:31-33, 18:8
