THE BIBLE HAS MUCH TO TEACH THOSE

... One Baptism ...

(Part I)

In Ephesians 4:5 the Bible teaches us that for the church there is <u>ONE BAPTISM</u>. Lets learn what Baptism is and what it does. In Acts 8:36-38 we see that Baptism is immersion in water. The word Baptism in the original Greek means "immerse". The Bible teaches a great deal about it.

- Jesus clearly taught that it was necessary Mark 16:16
- Jesus taught His followers to perform it and teach everyone. **Matthew 28:19-20**
- Jesus exampled it Matthew 3:13-17, Mark 1:9-11
- The Apostles taught it at their first opportunity **Acts 2:19-42**
- They taught that it would apply to everyone **Matthew 28:19, Acts 2:38-39**
- They taught that its necessity would continue for all time <u>Acts 2:39</u>
- It was applied in all conversions even when Apostles were surprised **Acts 10:47-48**
- The History of Early church growth (Acts) gives many examples <u>Acts 2:24; 8:12, 13, 38; 9:18; 10:48; 16:15, 33; 18:8; 19:5</u>
- Sometimes Baptism was commanded by the teacher **Acts 22:16**
- Sometimes Baptism was requested by the student **Acts 8:36**
- It was such a natural part of the teaching that sometimes it wasn't even mentioned in the written Word; but it was obeyed -Acts 8:12-13,8:35-38; 16:15, 16:31-33, 18:8
