## **SAVED BY HIS LIFE**

Jesus appeared to John on Patmos. He declared that He was dead, but now He lives forevermore (**Revelation 1:18**). Jesus saves because of what He does now, qualified by what He did back then (**Hebrews 2:10**). Paul affirmed, "For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life" (**Romans 5:10** NKJV). The suffering and death of Christ qualified Him to function as our High Priest before God at this hour.

Our Lord's present ministry must be kept in mind as one ponders, "I have a Savior." He is our Mediator (1 Timothy 2:5). He is our Advocate, face-to-face with the Father (1 John 2:1). He "always lives to make intercession" for us (Hebrews 7:25). His blood continues to cleanse us from all sin as we walk in the light (1 John 1:7).

Truly he saves to the uttermost (**Hebrews 7:25**). Christians <u>were saved</u> (past tense, **Romans 8:24**), <u>are being saved</u> (present tense, **1 Corinthians 15:2**). <u>Have been saved</u> (perfect tense, **Ephesians 2:5, 8**), and <u>shall be saved</u> (future tense, **Romans 5:9-10**) - wholly, completely, forevermore!

Jesus saves us from the penalty of sin (Romans 8:1-3). He delivers us from the fear of death (Hebrews 2:15). He saves us from the fear of judgment (1 John 2:17-19). He delivers us from the wrath to come (1 Thessalonians 1:10). We have a sympathetic high priest before the throne of grace (Hebrews 4:15-16) - at this hour.


