... One Baptism ... Eph 4:5

(Part II)

Baptism was taught to the early church in a great variety of ways.

- Jesus gave us Baptism as a clear part of our teaching the lost Matthew 28-18-20, Mark 16:16
- Baptism was mostly described in relation to Christ Romans 6:3-7; 1Corinthians 1:13-17; Galatians 3:27; Colossians 2:12
- Baptism was connected to Old Testament scriptures and events -1 Corinthians 10:2, 1 Peter 3:20-21
- It was presumed (known) that all in the church had been baptized Romans 6:3-5, 1 Corinthians 1:13-17; Galatians 3:27; Colossians 2:12 etc.
- Peter taught what baptism isn't 1 Peter 3:21
- Baptism was so second nature that it became to be emphasized and bragged about in the wrong way –
 1 Corinthians 1:13-17
- Baptism was used to describe not only our connection to Jesus but to His Body, the church —

1 Corinthians 12:13

- Baptism was emphasized so much that some failed to move on to learn about more mature subjects as they should **Hebrews 6:1-2**
- People were taught to get baptized right away Acts 22:16
- Believers who hadn't been, would be taught to be baptized correctly— Acts 18:24 19:5
- Baptism would be taught about both literally and symbolically <u>Acts 8:35-38; John 3:3-5;</u>
 <u>1John 5:5-7, Rom 6:3-5</u>
- The Bible CLEARLY says Baptism is required (!!!) Mark16:16; Acts 2:38; 22:16;1 Peter 3:21
- <u>EPHESIANS 4:3-6</u> The New Testament teaches that There is only ONE BAPTISM for the Christian.


